

Projects initiated by Sonning Common Parish Council from 2016 - 2018

1. Planting trees and bushes around the Village

Trees to replace ones that had died



A Japanese Cherry in the bed in front of Heath & Watkins



An Oak in the green space along Crowsley Way to replace a diseased tree that had to be removed

Trees or bushes to screen areas



The 2 Laurel bushes at the back help to screen the houses at the start of Kennylands Road.

The 3 Euonymus in the bed at the front help to brighten up the area throughout the year.



The Weeping Crab Apple replaces a much taller tree to screen that corner of Lea Road Play Area

2. Making safe and tidying up the area around Widmore Pond



The trees above the seats at Widmore Pond have been made safe, and the brambles have been cleared from the seat and log area





3. Working on the part of Old Copse recently acquired by the Parish Council

Dead trees or branches have been made safe, and the growth of Holly and Ivy along footpaths and in glades has been moderated.
